Individual private attorneys that contract with the government and are appointed by the Superior Court of California, County of Stanislaus to provide indigent defense because of a conflict declared by the Office of the Public Defender or Alternate Defenders Office or other court order. All obligations to protect the confidences of the client and zealously represent his or her interests are scrupulously maintained and respected.
